Invitation to the Seaplane Workshop at Biscarrosse on May 14th 2010

You are invited to the first workshop of the EC supported FUSETRA (FUTURE SEaplane TRAffic) programme on 14th May 2010 in Biscarrosse, France.

This is the first out of three workshops to be performed during the next 18 months. The first workshop is jointly organized by the FUSETRA team and the city of Biscarrosse on the occasion of the traditional Biscarrosse seaplane event to be held from 13th to 16th of May 2010.

FUSETRA is a research project in the European Community's 7th Framework Programme which investigates the current seaplane and amphibian aircraft transport system in order to provide the basis for future improvements. The aim is to evaluate strengths and weaknesses and to elaborate a set of concepts and requirements for a future seaplane air transportation system and according air vehicles to improve passenger choice in air transportation.

The first workshop's main topic is operational experience. Several keynote speeches will be given by operators and authorities (e.g. EASA).
