
## Dear Sir, Madam, Colleague pilots!

**Aeroklub Krainy Jezior** (Lakes District Aeroclub) - our organization, associating pilots and aviation enthusiasts, is located in Giżycko (NE of Poland), the heart of *Great Masurian Lakes District* - the finalist of "New 7 Wonders of Nature" conquest.



We organize, since the end of previous century, the annual *Friends of Aviation and Masuria International Fly-Inn* (which takes place this year 30 July – 2 August) which culmination is two days Mazury AirShow (1-2 August). The motto of fly-in is "come, rest and meet the Masuria".

## Mazury AirShow takes place in two neighbours localizations:

- **Ketrzyn-Wilamowo Airfield** (EPKE) base airfield for all aviation operations, static displays, pilots meetings, press conferences... Airfield filled-up with history established in 1935 and in 1941 expanded as the airport for secret Hitler's headquarter "Wolf's Lair" ("Wolfschanze"). Here, took-off in Heinkel He 111, colonel Claus von Stauffenberg just after Hitler's assassination attempt, during Operation "Valkyria" and it was here, where in February 1942 the plane with Fritz Todt on board, crashed shortly after take-off.
- Niegocin lake one of the biggest polish lake, natural amphitheater, whose three main advantages we are trying to use as best as we can its scenic, charm value, accessibility for visitors and the opportunity to present the full capabilities of seaplanes. This is the main place of dynamic displays. The show can be watched by viewers from the beach, pier, shores and all kind of vessels in the safety zones.

The admission entrance is free of charge, the air show take place in a middle of summer holidays and in the heart of polish best holiday destination so we gather every year tens of thousands spectators as also wide spectrum of media attention.

Over the past 17 years we had the pleasure and honour to host, during our fly-ins and air shows, many national and international owners, operators and flying crews in the construction of military, aerobatic, historical and, very for us important seaplanes.
